- 10 Vote on the submission of approved changes to the records to the Chief Appraiser;
- 11 Vote on the Approval of the Appraisal Records for return to the Chief Appraiser per Section 41.12 of the Texas Property Tax Code and any other governing laws;
- 12 Discuss, consider and vote regarding policies, procedures and new forms, if any;
- 13 Old business if any;
